

2015 Sonoma County Rosé Wine

The first glimpse at the 2015 vintage is through the lens of this beautiful iridescent pink wine. Since 2013, the shift in winemaking for the rosé has been on creating a very refreshing and serious wine. 2015 delivers on this mission with intense aromatic qualities of fresh orange blossoms, pink grapefruit and watermelon. One sip and you're transported to an island beach with distinct flavors of guava, papaya and passion fruit. Constructed this year with 60% Syrah, followed by equal parts of 14% of Mourvèdre, Grenache and Pinot Noir.

The palate mirrors our desire for structure with an enticing fresh mid-palate that flows into a chalky, quenching finish. We encourage you to not just drink this next to the pool;

barbeque and light fare throughout the summer will be enhanced with this delicious rosé.
