

2009 Sonoma County Cuvée Keltie Syrah

What a vintage for Donelan Wines, and as a result what a vintage for Cuvee Keltie. The 2009 Keltie is a big wine without being exhausting, full of flavor without being contrived with over ripeness. Loaded with aromas that evoke smoked herbs such as lavender and fennel, there are also notes of blackberry, cherry, licorice, and hints of black pepper. Even with all that, the best thing about this wine is its ability to be at once weighty, textured, and rich while retaining suppleness, structure, length, and hints of minerality. This wine is beautiful, masculine, and should age very well. Enjoy while it lasts.
